The Story

The Village of Hillside and the Plote Companies have teamed up to build a home, free of charge, for disabled Veteran Sergio Lopez and his family. Lopez, of Joliet, was injured during Operation Iraqi Freedom. Through the help of the IL Department of Veterans Affairs, Sergio Lopez was chosen to be the recipient of this home. Sergio Lopez is 27 years old, served two tours of duty in Iraq and in January of 2006, was struck by an Improvised Explosive Device (IED, commonly known as a roadside bomb) in Iraq. The explosion resulted in Sergio losing both of his legs below his knees and changing his life forever. He and his wife have two young daughters and the rehabilitation this young man has gone through and continues to endure, is extensive. Over a year of project planning efforts and fundraising has put this project in a position to move forward.
